



MedITEX instructions for clinical IT administrators:

Standard MedITEX WebPortal Installation

- 1. Right-click on the ZIP-file with WebPortal installation, choose "Extract All", and save everything in a folder named "WebPortal".
- 2. Install the "fmsoft_unigui_extjs_0.93.0.996_setup.exe"




Right-click on "mexWebPortal_Install.bat" -> Edit.
 Change this part of the path to the current path of the WebPortal folder.



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Right-click on "mexWebPortal_Uninstall.bat -> Edit".
 Change this part of the path to the current path of the WebPortal folder and save it.




- 5. Right-click on "Recdate.ini" -> Edit.
 - ➤ Change "*localhost*" to the Firebird database location of MedITEX IVF:

There is already a "Recdate.ini" file in the MedITEX VF folder. Open this file and compare them. If MedITEX WebPortal is not located on the same server as the IVF, change "localhost" from the WebPortal Recdate.INI file to the same server-id in the "Recdate.ini" file from the IVF folder. Be sure that the "DBAlias" are the same in both "Recdate.ini" files.






6. Right-click on "mexWebPortal_Install.bat" -> Run as administrator After finishing you should see this window:




7. Open the "Control Panel -> Windows Firewall -> Advanced settings"

Click on "Inbound Rules" and choose "New Rule..."




Select "Port" and click "Next"






Choose "TCP" and "Specific local ports" and set the port to 8077 (If this port has already been possessed, you should enter another one – do not forget to change it in RecDate.ini also!)



Click "Next" until the name is asked for.

Specify the name and optional a description and click "Finish".



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Repeat step 7 with "Outbound Rules":



8. Now it is possible to access the MedITEX WebPortal in a browser with following URL: http://server-id:8077

Your server-id: The current server-id from step 5 that is also in the "Recdate.ini".
